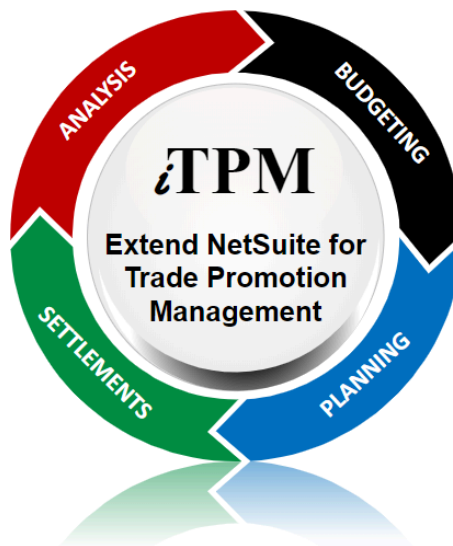

We test iTPM using the Chrome browser.



**You may be required to update to 25.2.2** before iTPM 26.1.1 is published. Any NetSuite accounts not updated by this date will be notified when their account will be updated.

# 1.0 Overview

## 1.1 Enhancements in iTPM **25.2.2**

The following changes were made to iTPM 25.2.1 and are included in iTPM version 25.2.2.

- iTPM 25.2.1 was tested with NetSuite 2025.2, and recertified as Build-for-NetSuite
- This list begins with Agile Development iteration #385 through #391
- **Defect** tickets start with “D”.
- **Enhancement** tickets start with an “S”
- **Notable enhancements are bolded and described in the What's new in iTPM? PowerPoint.**

Iteration 373

- S-06829: Back dated e-accruals show the wrong item in the saved search result set under the financial Accrual Detail subtab on the promotion. (Accrual
- S-06838: Back dated e-accruals calculate the wrong quantity for the accrual because of an incorrect UOM conversion.
- S-06833: Back dated e-accruals show the correct item, but the wrong allowance for the item.
- D-01699: Issue with Bulk Expense. Under some circumstances, the script does not create a journal entry when the deduction includes tax.
- D-01700: Bulk CSV Bulk Settlements are stuck processing because the iTPM Applied to field is blank, and it should be the iTPM deduction #.

Republish iTPM 25.1.2 (Defects D-01699 and D-01700) S-06838

- S-06832: Back dated e-accruals calculate the wrong quantity for the accrual. (UOM conversion issue.)
- S-06833: Back-dated event-accruals show the correct item, but the wrong allowance for the item.
- S-06939: Change the MR script for Bulk Settlements to run as "iTPM Support (Admin)" role instead of user's role.
- S-06871: Add "Lists -> Tax Records VIEW to the iTPM Support (Admin)" role.
- S-06867: DA-03: Daily E-accruals: Existing map reduce scripts must skip creating financial accruals if the Daily Accruals checkbox is checked in the promotion type.
- S-06874: In the "- iTPM Plan, Settlements & DDN (non admin)" role, change the PLAN permission from VIEW to EDIT.
- **S-06821: Add new fields to the Retail Info sublist to store 3rd party syndicated data for the promotion to support sell-through KPIs by item.**
- **S-06835: Create new fields in the iTPM Retail Event custom record to store data from other sources, like iData**
- S-06873: Change some iTPM scripts from "iTPM Support" back to "NS Admin" because of issues with the "- iTPM Support (Admin)" role lacking required role permissions, and clients removing permission from

the role.

Republish iTPM 24.1.2 to include new fields in Retail Info custom record (S-06821)

- Iteration 374

Republish iTPM 25.1.2 to include missing User Event script for creating deductions from JEs.

- S-06880: In all iTPM Event Accruals, populate NetSuite entity 'name' in the lines with the iTPM customer. (All MR e-accrual scripts.).
- S-06881: Put S-06858 into Dev 2 for publishing: Transaction accruals and missed transaction accruals need CLASS populated based on the item class.
- S-06856: Change the existing transaction accrual MR scripts to run the back-dated transaction accrual as the last script in the chain. See section 6.9 for scripts that are chain run.
- S-06893: iTPM 25.1.2 has a UOM allowance UOM conversion issue for promotions where the price level is "Customer Specific Price". The NetSuite UOM for customer specific prices under the customer record is assumed to always be the UOM type = Primary Unit of Measure. (See also S-06854 and S-06801)
- **S-06882: Add a new checkbox in the promotion type to support an enhancement in the next version of iTPM: "Update Liability using 3rd party data".**
- S-06889: Make location visible in the iTPM Accrual form.
- S-06868: DA-03 Daily E-Accruals / Develop: The existing MR scripts must SKIP creating non-allocated financial accruals when the "Daily Allocated Accruals" checkbox is checked in the accrual configuration.
- S-06672: GST-39: Design how to round iTPM GST tax calculations the same way that NetSuite does, using the NetSuite currency decimal configuration precision.

Republish iTPM 25.1.2 to add missing .JS object for creating deductions from journals.

- S-06844: Populate NAME in the iTPM period accruals with the iTPM Customer.
- S-06811: Populate Class in the iTPM Period Accruals based on the item's product class.
- S-06901: Populate department in the iTPM Accruals for transaction and missed transaction event triggers.
- S-06767: Research & design how we can populate the Promotion Planning Key into the Retail Info records, similar to how Process Plan, the PP4AP and other scripts work for allowance records.

S-06905: Republish iTPM 25.1.2: Includes S-06901

- D-01708: Daily accruals do not work correctly when there is a decrease in an item's accrual multiple times.
- D-01710: The Tax JE has the full deduction amount in the memo field when it should only have the amount of the tax. (See also S-06916)
- S-06886: Document the fields that are used by iTPM to manage GST. Confirmed, all GST fields are currency fields. [No action required]
- S-06877: Populate entity name in the period-accrual lines, also populate class and department based on

values in the item record.

- D-06945: Add columns to the "iTPM Export Proms to Plans" saved search to make it easier to re-import promotions from production to sandbox for testing.
- D-01712: Remove 'date last modified' from two map reduce scripts, the Transaction and Backdated scripts for event-accruals. (See also S-06929)

Iteration 376

- S-01720: Daily Allocated Accrual is not self correcting. (See also S-06941, and S-06937)
- S-06954: Add a new column, % completion, under the Financial Accrual Detail sublist in the promotion.
- S-06959: Create a new checkbox in the iTPM Event Accrual record, "Use Foreign Currency", and default it to unchecked.
- D-01719: Period Share and Item Share records are not always created for CLOSED promotions. (See also S-06956)
- D-01718: Daily Allocated Accruals must include all Active, Approved promotions, even when KPIs are not updated in the last 3 days. (See also S-06970, S-06946)
- D-01715: The Optimized KPI MR script generated an error when the KPI date-last-updated format was not Day/Month/Year. (See also S-06940)
- D-01716: Bulk Settlement was not recognizing the deduction number because of a missing .JS script in the iTPM bundle. (See also S-06969)
- S-01717: For subsidiaries that don't use the parent subsidiary currency, the Actual Spend KPI was in the wrong currency. (See also S-06934)
- S-06865: Fields renamed in iTPM Retail Event info so they are not iData specific.

Republish iTPM 25.1.2 to correct defects in Daily Allocated Accruals 25.1.2

- D-01701: No Daily Accruals were created for closed promotions under some circumstances. See also S-06966.
- S-06976: Design on how to prevent failed GST JEs when settlements are created through CSV Bulk Settlements.
- S-06957: Fix an issue with the Mass Status Change script, where promotion status is not changed in some situations.
- D-01722: Issue with the Mass Status Change moving promotions from Approved Status to other statuses, including Draft and Closed.
- S-05676: DA-00, Epic stories for Daily Accruals are completed.
- S-06967: iTPM Retail Info subtab fields are not in the order in the design document.
- D-01713: No accrual log or accruals are created for closed-promotions.
- S-06949: The allocation script for approved promotions must also run for closed promotions.

Republish iTPM 25.1.2 for bug fixes and to unlock workflow for testing. (S-6973)

- D-01723: In some situations, no Daily Allocated Accruals are created when they should be. (See also D-01724)

Republish iTPM 25.1.2 to correct defects. (S-07009)

- S-07010: Dev 2: Closed promotion, Daily Allocated Accrual record must have item detail in the lines, the same as all other daily accrual records.
- S-07025: Filters added to iTPM -> Resolutions - All Settlements
- S-07024: Removed filter from iTPM -> Resolutions -> Adjustments to eliminate duplicates in the result set, and added Bill Close date and promotion #.
- S-06700: GST-36: Review Design & Develop: Support "Mass Void for Settlements" by CSV import.
- S-06986: Bulk Settlements script requires the user to have EDIT permission for the "Bulk Settlements" custom record. Fields used by scripts changed to inline text for security.
- D-01703: Sometimes the promotion allocation factors for lump sum and/or bill-back are incorrect or missing.
- S-07018: Change the column name to "% Allocation", and the field name in the accrual record.

Republish iTPM 25.1.2 (D-01703) S-07027

- S-06998: Make the retail Info record fields available for CSV import, including promotions in approved status.
- S-06988: Optimize the period-accrual script so it can create accrual records for iTPM clients that have more than 4,000 items and 5,000 daily invoices.
- S-07048: New field in the deduction record, "Open Balance Pending", to help prevent over resolution of a deduction when JEs are pending approval. (See also S-06984)
- S-07037: Identify journal entry GST reversals in a new column in the Applied Transaction sublist on the deduction form.

Publish iTPM 25.1.2 to correct known defect (S-07055)

- S-07002: P2P script: Design: Allow update to Estimated Volume to approved promotions.
- S-07080: Design: How to allow KPI refresh to work for clients with and without foreign currency. (currency filter)
- D-01728 Transaction accrual UOM is not displayed correctly in the accrual record. (See also 7085)
- D-01729 Incremental Qty sometimes is calculated as a float value, and must be an integer for KPI refresh to finish. See also S-07084.
- D-01730 Remove the currency filter in the Daily Accrual MR script, as it prevents accruals from being created in some NetSuite instances. See also S-07069
- D-01731 Allow KPIs to work for clients with and without Currency filter and Currency Column foreign currency. (removed currency filter) See also S-07087



- S-06971 Change Daily Accrual MR script to use NetSuite "Use Foreign currency" configuration.
- S-07120: The UI for Settlements Expense, Quick Expense, and Reinvoice should use "Open Balance Pending" to prevent over-resolutions of deductions.

Republish iTPM 25.1.2 to make defect fixes available (S-07086)

- S-07064: When using the date parameter to create back-dated Period Accruals, the accrual transaction date should match the parameter date.
- D-01732: Deduction status and open balance does not always get updated when a journal entry GST reversal is created. (See also S-07090)

Iteration 379

- S-07081: Add two new fields in the accrual record to store % Allocation for Lump Sum, and % Allocation Bill-Back.
- **S-07031: Design a new Settlement Adjustment validation: The Settlement amount can't be more than the bill amount linked to the settlement. (Validation in the browser)**
- S-07096: The Period field in the Event Plan should not be a required field. Allow Null values.
- S-07034: Create three new "Net of Tax" fields that will always be updated in the deduction.
- S-07105: Move three 'net of tax' stored values under the custom subtab on the deduction, and the three real-time new 'saved search' net of tax fields to the deduction form.
- S-05691: Design a new 'limited' Promotion Mass Submit, Approve and Close forms for non-admin users.
- S-07095: Fix the journal entry event script, to update the deduction status and open balance when a GST JE reversal is created.
- S-07111: Net-of-Tax fields should not be editable if you EDIT or Quick Split a deduction.
- S-07112: Remove "NEW" from the iTPM -> Admin -> Mass Status Queue and Mass Status Change menus.
- S-07049: The Bulk Settlement Resolution Queue should include "journal entries pending approval" in the validation when creating settlements.
- S-06904: Process Plan should populate the Promotion Planning Key in the Retail Info record.
- S-07094: Period Accrual MR script: When script runs with blank parameter date, date should be yesterday's date, the same as the invoice create date corresponding to the accrual.

Iteration 380

- S-07109: For active promotions, Daily Allocated Accruals must calculate the percent allocation of the lump sum separate from the bill-back allocation when the promotion type is linked to shipments.
- S-07129: Populate the Daily Allocated Accrual allocations for Lump sum and Bill Back into the accrual record.
- S-07116: The P4AP script should populate the promotion planning key in the Retail Info record

- D-01738: Accrual fields in the promotion form should not be open for editing. (Also S-07132)
- D-01734: The lump sum % allocation should not be rounded in the Daily Allocated Accrual.
- **S-07067: P2P script: Allow users to update Estimated Volume in approved promotions using the Event Plan if the role has appropriate permissions.**
- D-01735: Changes to populate department in the settlement lines caused the Adjust Spend button on the promotion to not create a Settlement Adjustment.
- Iteration 381
- S-07118: Enhance the MR Allowance for New Item(Sc) script so it populates the Promotion Planning Key in the retail Info record.
- S-07134: Move department from the header to the lines in the settlement, and populate department in the lines based on Global NetSuite configurations.
- D-01737: The field 'Original Estimated Spend' should not be open for editing.  
Republish iTPM 25.1.2 (S-07130)
- S-07147: Under the Accrual subtab in the promotion, hide a column in the Financial Accrual Summary sublist saved search.
- **S-07097: Optimize the Plan-toPromotion script so that it will run in less time.**
- S-07104: For the CSV Bulk Import, add a validation for Settlement Adjustments, so the amount can't be more than the transaction amount that's linked to the settlement.
- S-07151: When the non-optimized P2P script updates volume in an approved promotion, another script incorrectly clears the Processing notes and Processing status.  
Republish iTPM 25.1.2 (S-07169)
- S-0744: Rename and un-deploy the 'old' MR Mass Status Update script to prevent confusion for admin users.
- **S-07108: MSC-02a: Create an easier way to Mass SUBMIT your promotions for approval**
- **S-07122: MSC-02b: Create an easier way to Mass SUBMIT your promotions for approval**
- S-07185: Include an OPT Plan to Promotion script into the iTPM Bundle.
- S-07082: Design,when creating the discount item in the sales order, populate location from the item. If there is no location in the item record, then use location from the discount item. Also S-07200, S-07203.
- S-07079: New KPI Optimized script does not trigger when the KPI refresh record type is ad-hoc, status change and settlement change.
- D-01740: The P2P script error message does not always populate in the Plan Processing Message.  
Iteration 382  
S-07192: Turn off the Duplicate Item Banner because there are too many false positive alerts.

- S-07176: Change the text in the column names in the Mass Submit and Mass Close promotion list.
  - S-07171: If the price level in a promotion is null, the Process Plan script will populate the price level with base price.
  - S-07202: The user event script on the Retail Event record should trigger a KPI refresh when the promotion type has "true-up" checked and the retail event data changes.
  - S-07208: Increase the number of promotion records to process in each script cycle of the Process Plan MR script.
  - S-07152: Design: Enhance the KPI optimized scripts to use the Retail Info 'Actual Units' fields for the Expected Liability KPI when the new "True-up" promotion type option is checked.
  - S-07172: The lump-sum Estimated allocation factors should not be evenly spread across items when there is actual sales volume for items in the promotion.
  - D-01741: The new iTPM -> Mass Status Change Queue saved search does not return results.
  - S-07017: Transaction / Missed Transaction Accruals: Populate location in the accrual using the location value from the associated fulfillment.
  - D-01705: Copy promotion should default or clear performance dates based on the new promotion type configuration.
  - **S-07124: Design and Develop: iTPM -> Promotions -> Mass Status Queue**
  - **S-07150: Design and Develop: iTPM -> Promotions -> Mass Approve**
- Republish iTPM 25.1.2 to make bug fixes available to iTPM clients.
- S-07117: Overnight Allowances sold MR script: It should populate the Promotion Planning Key fields in the Retail Info record, Allowance and Est Quantity records.
  - S-06866: Design: MOP pop-up should fix the MOP by defaulting to the first valid MOP instead of a warning message.
  - D-01695: The Monthly Base saved search in the Event Plan shows inactive records in the Event Plan subtab.
  - S-07222: Add "Allow cross sub viewing" to the standard "- iTPM Customer Service SO" role.
  - S-07218: Add "Accounting Lists" = VIEW to the "iTPM Broker (Custom Center)" role.
  - S-07199: KPIs for OIs include overlapping transactions, but not when the transactions are more than two levels down.
  - D-01742: The Optimized Plan to Promotion script: When plans are grouped, the lump sum in the promotion header must be the sum of LS for all plans.
  - S-07229: The Mass Approve Suitelet had "all internal users" unchecked when it should be checked.
  - S-07221: Add Mass APPROVE to the iTPM Menu for most iTPM roles.

Republish iTPM 25.1.2 to make bug fixes available to iTPM clients.

## Iteration 383

- S-07228: When adding a new planning row in a promotion, instead of a warning, the script should just change the MOP to a valid MOP for the promotion type.
- S-07216: When iTPM creates the GST tax the script should not populate the reason code in the deduction.
- S-07217 Change the *customscript\_itpm\_je\_process\_support* script to exclude iTPM JEs that were used to create deductions. Changes to these JEs that create deductions should not change the deduction status and open balance.
- D-07216: For configurations where deductions include tax, the User Event Settlement Buttons script must run as the Administrator role to ensure that iTPM tax journal entries are created in real-time and auto-approved.
- D-01743: Accrual Log records for the event trigger "transaction" were not always created because of issues with the value of location in the fulfillment.
- D-01750: Actual Units KPI calculations in promotions sometimes incorrectly uses the last 52 weeks instead of the promotion dates.
- D-01744: The optimized and non-optimized Plan-to-Promotion script incorrectly sometimes changes the unit-of-measure in the Event Plan after processing.
- D-01751: The KPI actual units for bill-backs goes down only 2 levels in the NetSuite customer hierarchy. This is changed to include 3 levels.
- D-01748: Calculation corrections to the Daily Allocated Accruals.

- S-07266: Add a new validation: Do not allow users to submit more than 500 promotions for the Mass Submit, Close and Approve forms.
- D-01753: Daily Allocated Accruals is not using the maximum of Net Liability or Settlements in some configurations.
- S-07286: Create two new script parameters, one to turn on/off validations, one to use foreign currency to limit the Settlement Adjustment to be equal or less than the linked bill.
- D-01757 iTPM incorrectly failed Mass Close of approved promotions that had settlements or accruals. (See also S-07292)
- D-01756: Accrual Log records are not always created when they should be.
- S-07100: The Period-Accrual transaction date should be the date of the invoice if the period is open, not the date the accrual was created.
- S-06875: Enable the SPLIT LINES button on deductions created from JEs. (Populating the form is S-07293)
- S-07279: Populate the memo in the deduction lines in deductions created from JEs the same way as deductions created from credit memos.
- **S-07230: Update the Optimized NBOI script with enhancements made to the old NBOI scripts, with**

**option to easily flip between old and new.**

- S-07295: Make the price level visible in the promotion form for the 'iTPM Broker (custom center).  
Publish iTPM 25.2.1 (S-07274) Iteration 384
- S-07252: Two iTPM permission records were changed to allow the NetSuite Admin role to have FULL access in the permission list of the record.
- S-07252: Change permission records to allow the NetSuite Admin role to have full access in the permission list of the record.
- D-01755: Sometimes accrual log records and accruals are created when they should not.
- D-07310 and S-07314: Bulk Settlements should use other reference code from the Bulk Settlement Queue record.
- D-01754: Sometimes the accrual log record for lump-sum was not created.
- S-07319: Add 'Other Reference' as a column to all the settlement saved searches under iTPM -> Resolutions.
- S-07318: In the Mass Close promotion list, add a column, "Net Liability".
- S-07323: Change the GST JE report to group-by to eliminate duplicates.
- **S-07281: Add a subtab to NetSuite bills that shows settlement adjustments associated with it.**
- D-01758: Backdated accrual should look for transactions in child customers within the NetSuite customer hierarchy.
- **S-07306: Optimize the Remove NOBI script, and add SO button parameters to switch between optimized and non-optimized scripts.**
- S-07273: When creating iTPM JEs that resolve deductions, populate the "cost center" custom segment value based on values in the customer record in the JE. Do this as a parameter selection instead of a custom support script.

## Iteration 385

- D-01759: The Admin Tool allowed users to change promotions that had settlements and accruals from Approved to Voided.
- D-01763: Optimized NBOI script did not work as expected under some situations. Updated NBOI script to include removal for Apply = T, but Remove = F and Applied = F
- D-01761: NBOI apply discounts did not correctly calculate price for net bill (UOM conversions)
- S-07263: To reduce confusion, in the sales order, remove the report link for overlapping bill-back promotions. These have no impact for the NBOI script and applying discounts to sales orders.
- S-07273: Populate "cost center" custom segment value based on customer in the JE using a 'customer specific' parameter option. See also S-07213. This eliminates a custom support script.
- S-05302: Add "Subsidiary" to the promotion type from (View only)

Republish iTPM to add missing objects into the bundle (S-07324)

- S-01981 This is only a one-time issue if you have brokers that use the Advanced Partner Center to access iTPM. If you have partner management **not enabled** before you update or install iTPM, the criteria in the saved search, “- iTPM Partner Promotion List” will not have the correct search criteria. After you enable partner management, edit this search to enter the correct criteria shown below, **or simply update iTPM again**.

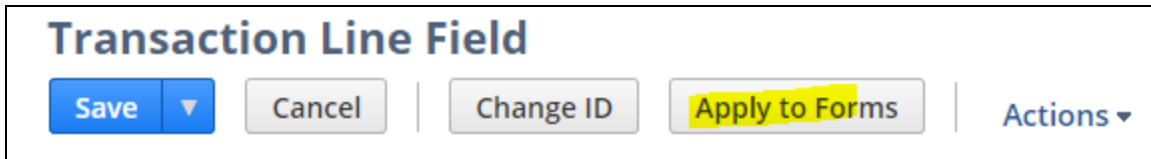

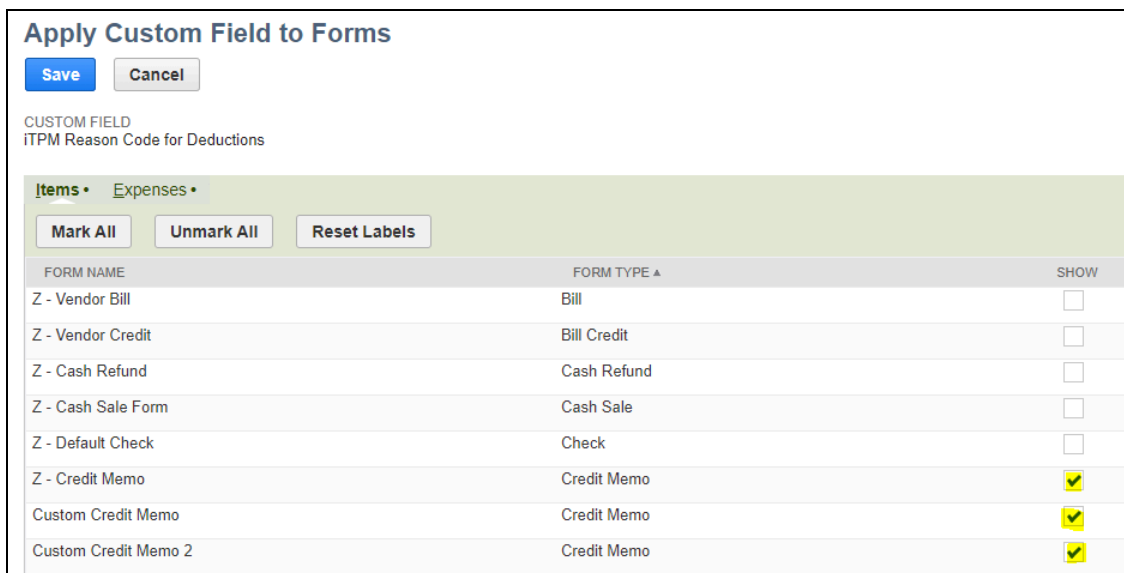

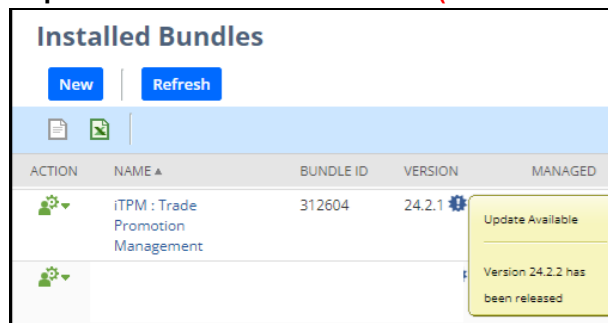
Updating a NetSuite Managed Bundle should generally follow the standard NetSuite updating steps.

### Step 1: Prepare for updating iTPM:

- For [task #1](#), get screenshots of the scheduled custom support scripts, and the standard iTPM scripts that were replaced (if any).
- For [task #2](#), make a list of the custom roles with iTPM permissions (if any).
- For [task #3](#), make a screenshot of the scripts that are currently scheduled.
- For [task #4](#), confirm you have the list of your customized iTPM script parameters.
- See if you need to download a list of settlement adjustments and voided settlements [before updating](#) iTPM.

### Step 2: Update the iTPM SuiteApp:

1. Confirm your account is not scheduled for [maintenance](#) when you want to update iTPM.
2. Go to **Customization > SuiteBundler > Search & Install Bundles -> LIST**.
3. Scroll up/down and find iTPM.
4. If iTPM is already installed in your account, NetSuite will show you that an update is available.
5. Click on the  green person/gear to the left of iTPM for a drop-down menu.
6. **On the drop-down menu select UPDATE. (DO NOT SELECT UNINSTALL)**



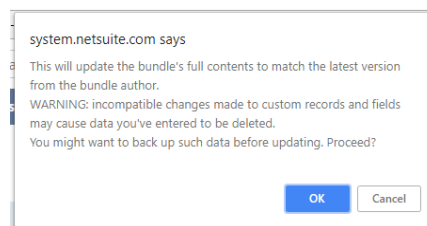
7. Follow the NetSuite update steps.

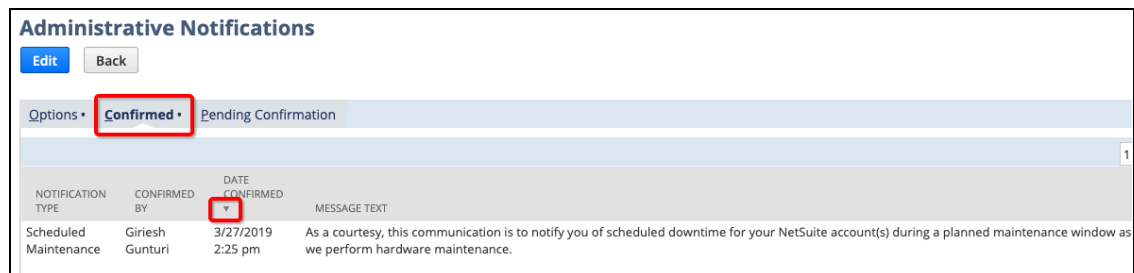
**Step 1: Contact CG Squared to schedule the update to iTPM in production.**

**Step 2: Prepare for updating iTPM:**

- For [task #1](#) after the update, get screenshots of the scheduled custom support scripts, and the standard iTPM scripts that were replaced (if any).
- For [task #2](#) after the update, make a list of the custom roles with iTPM permissions (if any).
- For [task #3](#) after the update, make a screenshot of the scripts that are currently scheduled.
- For [task #4](#) after the update, confirm you have the list of your customized iTPM script parameters.

Make sure your account is not scheduled for maintenance when you are updating iTPM.

1. Go to *Setup-> Company -> Administrative Notifications*
2. Go to the *Confirmed* subtab and sort the notices so the newest notices are on the top.

3. Look at the list and confirm there is no maintenance or down-time scheduled. Postpone your iTPM update if your account is scheduled for maintenance or downtime.



**IMPORTANT: DO NOT UNINSTALL iTPM from your live production account.**

Doing so after go-live will result in the loss of iTPM data, including all promotional data and custom transaction records that resolve your short-pays.



**IMPORTANT: UPDATE iTPM in your SANDBOX and/or Release Preview account for testing BEFORE UPDATING iTPM in your live production account.** While iTPM is easy to update, trade promotion has a material impact on your company's financial statements. We recommend sandbox testing prior to updating in production.

1. Before you request iTPM to be installed for the first time, confirm your production account has all of the necessary [prerequisites](#).
2. Email [support@cgsquared.com](mailto:support@cgsquared.com) to let us know you want iTPM installed in your production account. CG Squared will typically push the update after business hours, as recommended by NetSuite. Your administrator will receive notification that iTPM has been updated.
3. After the update is done, review and perform the [administrator tasks](#) listed in section 2.6.



**Note:** After iTPM is updated, you may see a few script errors. These errors typically end after 12 midnight on the day iTPM is updated. Email [support@cgsquared.com](mailto:support@cgsquared.com) if you observe iTPM NetSuite error messages the day after iTPM has been updated.



## 2.6 iTPM Administrator tasks (After Updating iTPM)



**Important:** If you skipped any iTPM updates, be sure to read the release notes for previous versions. You may need to perform some or all of those administrator tasks for the previous versions. If in doubt as to what tasks to perform after iTPM is updated, contact [support@cgsquared.com](mailto:support@cgsquared.com).

### 2.6 Task #1: Review custom support scripts (if any)

- If your organization or the CG Squared team created custom support scripts, it is important to review support scripts.
- Before updating iTPM, you took screenshots of the scheduled custom support scripts, and the standard iTPM scripts that were replaced.
  - In script lists, these typically are next to each other in the list
  - Both scripts typically start with the same name. The support script ends with `_supp`.
- If the new version of iTPM made changes to the script that was replaced by a support script, then the iTPM team may need to update the support script code for it to work properly.
- After iTPM is updated, compare your screenshots to the scripts. Unschedule, and sometimes un-deploy, the standard iTPM scheduled scripts that were replaced by custom scripts.



**IMPORTANT:** If you have custom support scripts, the standard iTPM script must be unscheduled and undeployed after iTPM is updated. Email [support@cgsquared.com](mailto:support@cgsquared.com) for help updating iTPM in your NetSuite instances.

### 2.6 Task #2 Review and update permissions in custom roles (if any)

- If you use iTPM standard roles, no action is needed. Skip ahead to task #3.
- If you add iTPM permissions to your custom roles, then do these tasks:
  - Make a list of the custom roles with iTPM permissions
  - Release notes will identify if permissions changed in any standard iTPM role.
  - You can also use *Setup -> Users/Roles -> Show Role Differences* and compare your custom roles with iTPM permissions to the corresponding iTPM standard role.
  - Add permissions as appropriate to your custom roles.
- More details on role permissions in Chapter 5 of the iTPM Admin User Guide.

### 2.6 Task #3: Review scheduled iTPM scripts

- Typically, the same scheduled scripts should also be scheduled after iTPM is updated.
- Before updating iTPM, you took screenshots of the scripts that were scheduled.
- After iTPM is updated, review the map-reduced scheduled scripts in NetSuite versus the scripts that were scheduled before the update.
- Compare the scheduled scripts to the typical scheduled scripts on the next page.

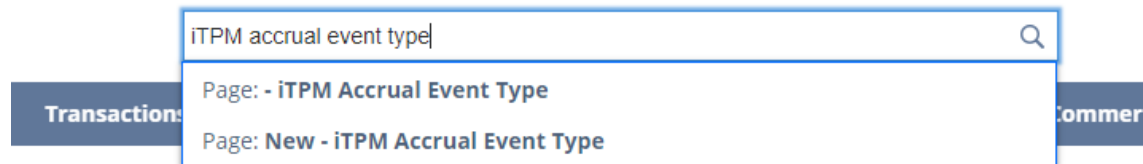

### Task #2: (Update to 24.1.2)

There are two new role permissions for planning to make changes to approved promotions:

#### - iTPM Modify Promotion

-> EDIT gives permission to see the MODIFY button.

-> FULL gives permission to APPROVE & REJECT changes to approved promotions.

#### - iTPM Planning Permission

-> EDIT or higher gives permission to add new items to approved promotions.

**Simply clicking on KPI Refresh will make the button visible.** You can also use QUICK EDIT, then cancel without making changes. Another option is to put all promotions into the KPI Refresh queue.

1. Go to **iTPM -> Promotions -> List**, and set your filter to see all APPROVED promotions.
2. Use a CSV import to put these promotions into the KPI Refresh queue
  - a. Custom record is "- iTPM KPI Queue"
  - b. Map promotion "Name / Title" to Name
  - c. Set Queue Request type to "Ad Hoc"
3. To monitor the results, go to **iTPM -> Promotions -> KPI Processing Queue**

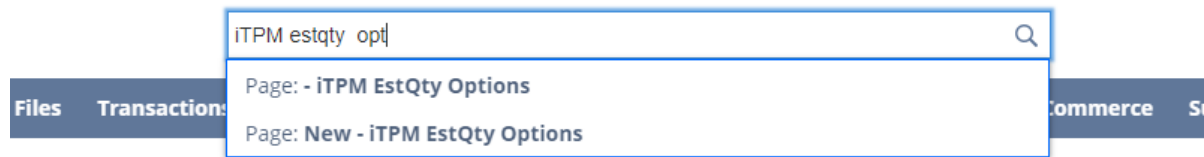

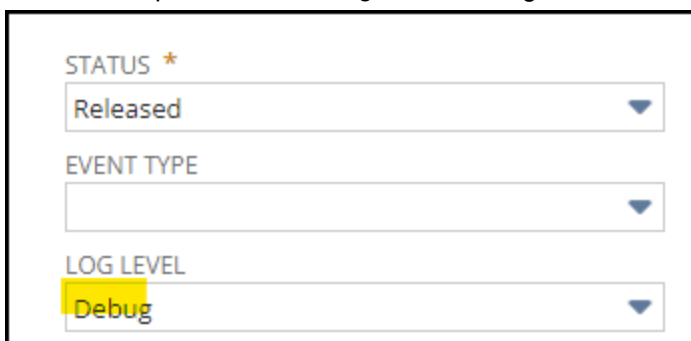

## 2.7 Suggested Sandbox Testing

We recommend clients that have sandboxes test iTPM before updating their production account.



**Note:** If you installed the iTPM managed bundle, your user ID cannot be used for role-based testing. As the implementer, your ID may show workflow buttons that should not be visible based on the role you are testing. **Role-based testing should be done with user IDs that have not installed or updated the iTPM managed bundle.**



**IMPORTANT:** Install iTPM in your **SANDBOX** account for testing **BEFORE** installing in your live production account. While iTPM is easy to install, and requires a minimum amount of effort to configure, **trade promotion has a material impact on your company's financial statements.** We recommend sandbox testing prior to go-live in production.



**Important:** You, as iTPM administrator, are responsible for setting up any new preferences, NetSuite settings, and performing any other tasks that are required by this updated version of iTPM. Be sure to read ALL of the tasks in this chapter before you begin testing iTPM in your sandbox.



**Important:** Your organization is responsible for configuring the GL-account for open deductions and other iTPM financial configurations. Always create and resolve deductions in your sandbox before implementing them in production. Run financial reports to confirm the financial impact is correct and acceptable to your organization. **It is possible to incorrectly configure the open deduction GL account, reason codes, promotion types, etc. in a way that creates 'bad data'. You are responsible for confirming the GL impact of your iTPM configurations.**



**Helpful hints for testing in Release Preview Accounts:** Scheduled scripts do not run in release preview accounts. To run iTPM scheduled scripts manually, go to section 6.9 in the Admin User Guide.

## 2.8 Schedule iTPM scripts After a Sandbox Refresh

As a NetSuite administrator, you have the ability to schedule map-reduce scripts.

In NetSuite 2023.1 and newer, a sandbox refresh changes all scheduled scripts to **UNSCHEDULED**.

All of the iTPM features that work by scheduled script will stop working after a sandbox refresh.

Here are examples of what will NOT work until you re-schedule iTPM scripts:

- Split, CSV Split
- Expense, Mass-Expense
- Actions->Copy of a promotion
- Mass Copy of Promotions
- Mass Non-GL Update
- Applying and Removing off-invoice discounts to sales orders
- Allocating items in a settlement
- Create promotions from plans
- ... and more
- [These are the typical iTPM SCHEDULED scripts:](#)
- These are steps to re-schedule iTPM scripts after your sandbox refresh:
  1. Login to production to get a list of scheduled scripts in production
  2. To view these scheduled scripts:
    - Go to **Customization -> Scripting -> Script Deployments**,
    - set the *TYPE* filter to *Map/Reduce*, and
    - Status to *Scheduled*.
    - Sort the list on script NAME so the iTPM scripts sort to the top.
    - Print or save the list
  3. Login in your sandbox.
  4. To view MR Unscheduled scripts:
    - Go to **Customization -> Scripting -> Script Deployments**,
    - Set the *TYPE* filter to *Map/Reduce*, and
    - Status to **UNSCHEDULED**.
    - Sort the list on script NAME so the iTPM scripts sort to the top.
    - For each scheduled script in production:
      - EDIT each **UNSCHEDULED** script in your sandbox that should be scheduled.
      - Change the script to **SCHEDULED**, and
      - **SAVE**.
